This survey was performed at the request of Penny Bennett. The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries as described in Instrument No. 041601, deeds of Grant County, Oregon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this property. The deeds of the adjoining properties were examined to identify any conflicts. After the deed boundaries were determined the landowners agreed to a new common boundary as shown. I used the deed record to establish the north, east and west boundaries. The south boundary is at the location agreed upon by the

The bearings for this survey are based on the north line of Survey No. 975. A number of surveys have been done in this area, Survey No. 209 indicates that there are unrecorded monuments from a survey done by Elton Saunders, LS 405, in this area. I found an unrecorded pin near the SE corner of this property which I can not accept without knowledge of the procedure used to establish it or who may have put the pin in the ground. Some of the records of the surveys done by Elton Saunders are in the office of Behort Broatt A come of the records of the surveys done by Elton Saunders are in the office of Robert Bagett. A copy of the unrecorded survey referred to in Survey No. 209 was provided, but it did not indicate that a monument was set in the location of
