NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Don Schultz. The purpose of this survey was to establish Mr. Schultz's property corners.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found Survey No. 1672, which was a dependent resurvey of Sections 7 and 8. The controlling corners of Section 8 were either found or established on Survey No. 1672, with the exception of the SE section corner. The SE section corner was re-monumented by Carl Stout on behalf of the U.S. Forest Service from original corner evidence. I accepted the corners monuments which I found during this survey and further subdivided Section 8 to establish the remaining corners of Mr. Schultz's property. Two monuments were set at the intersection of the subdivisional line and at the center of an existing road which is the southerly boundary of Parcel 1, Land Partition Plat No. 2002-07.
