


NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Mark Stubstad. The purpose of this survey was to re—establish the boundary between Lot 4 and Lot 5, Block 3, Amended Crisp Heights Homesites.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Survey No. 1372 shows the surveyed line between Lots 4 and 5, Block 3. I searched for the monuments at both ends of this line. They were not found. A new sewer line runs just south of this property line and probably accounts for the monuments being gone. I found and accepted the monuments shown hereon. I held the plat record distance and set the NW corner of Lot 5 on line between the found monuments. From this monument I used the plat record bearing and intersected the right of way line which was established from the found center line monuments of SW Fourth St. Drive.
