


MAIN STREET



SURVEY NARRATIVE

IN ANTICIPATION OF THE RECONSTRUCTION OF SE DAYTON STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF JOHN DAY, OREGON, THE ACCOMPANYING SURVEY DRAWING WAS PREPARED TO DOCUMENT THE EXISTENCE AND LOCATION OF SURVEY MONUMENTS WHICH MAY BE REMOVED OR DISTURBED BY THE ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. OREGON REVISED STATUTES-CHAPTER 209 PROVIDES THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DOCUMENTATION, PRESERVATION AND RESTORATION OF SURVEY MONUMENTS OF RECORD IN THE CIRCUMSTANCE OF ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION. THE ACCOMPANYING SURVEY MAP IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED BASIS FOR THE RELOCATION OF ANY SURVEY MONUMENT OF RECORD WHICH MAY BE DISTURBED BY THE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES.

THE RESEARCH OF PUBLIC RECORDS FOR THIS SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED IN NOVEMBER, 2003 AND MAY, 2006, FOLLOWED BY THE PRIMARY FIELD SURVEY WHICH WAS CONDUCTED DURING DECEMBER, 2003, AND JANUARY, 2004. ADDITIONAL FIELD SURVEYS WERE PERFORMED IN MAY, 2006 TO TIE NEW MONUMENTS ESTABLISHED SINCE 2004, AND TO CONFIRM THE CURRENT EXISTENCE AND CONDITION OF THE MONUMENTS WHICH WERE RECOVERED IN 2003-2004. THE LOCATION OF SEARCH AREAS FOR EXISTING SURVEY MONUMENTS WAS BASED ON THE EXISTENCE OF MONUMENTATION AS SHOWN ON THE RECORDS CITED IN THE REFERENCE MATERIAL LISTING SHOWN HEREON. FIELD SURVEY MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE WITH A TOPCON GT5802A ELECTRONIC TOTAL STATION WITH ELECTRONIC DATA COLLECTION, HAVING STANDARD DEVIATION VALUES OF 3 SECONDS ANGULAR AND +-0.01'+3PPM DISTANCE.

THE RESULTS OF THIS SURVEY MONUMENT RECOVERY EFFORT ARE DOCUMENTED IN TABULAR FORMAT ON THIS SURVEY DRAWING. THE DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENTS FOUND OR SEARCHED FOR-NOT FOUND IS BASED ON THE CONDITIONS WHICH EXISTED AT THE TIME OF THE FIELD SURVEYS IN 2003-2004 AND 2006.

AS PART OF THE RECONSTRUCTION OF SE DAYTON STREET, IT IS THE INTENT OF THE CITY OF JOHN DAY TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF CERTAIN SURVEY MONUMENTS WHICH WILL BE REMOVED BY THE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. THESE MONUMENT LOCATIONS HAVE BEEN NOTED ON THIS DRAWING. UPON THE REPLACEMENT OF SURVEY MONUMENTS AT THESE LOCATIONS. ADDITIONAL SURVEY RECORDS DESCRIBING THE NATURE OF THE NEW MONUMENT WILL BE PREPARED.
