NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Greg Armstrong. The purpose was to establish the west and south boundary of Mr. Armstrong's property as described in Inst. No. 051801, deeds of Grant County.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. During Survey No. 336 the SE and SW corners of Block H were established. I found and accepted both of these monuments. Survey No. 336 also indicates that monuments were set at the NE and NW corners of Mr. Armstrong's property. I found a monument at the NE corner which was set during the survey for Land partition No. 2005–27. The monument at the NW corner was found lying out of the ground. I found and accepted the monuments from Land Partition No. 2005–27 as shown. The monuments set in this survey were established in accordance with the monuments found and at the record positions shown on Survey No. 336.
