## NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Dean Rogers. The purpose of this survey was to establish the lines and corners for a boundary adjustment between Parcel 2 and Parcel 3 of Land Partition No. 2003—8.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Land Partition Plat No. 2003—8 shows the south and east lines of the NW1/4 of Section 32. Section 32 was subdivided in 1998 by Survey No. 1482. I accepted the found monuments shown hereon. I established the new corner monuments on line between the found monuments and at the locations approved by Mr. Rogers.
