NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Dean Rogers. The purpose of this survey was to establish the lines and corners for a boundary adjustment between Parcel 1 and Parcel 2 of Land Partition No. 2003—8.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. I found and accepted five monuments from Survey No. 1160, on the easterly right of way line of County Road No. 76. I established the NW and SW corners of this survey on line between the found monuments as shown. The remaining monuments were established at the locations approved by Mr. Rogers.
