#### NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Dean Rogers and Bob Rex. The purpose of this survey was to establish the lines and corners for a boundary adjustment. The boundaries of Parcels 1, 2 and 3 of Partition No. 2003-8 and the boundaries of Parcels 1 and 2 of Partition No. 96-11 have been adjusted.

I found and accepted the corners of the NE1/4 and the NW1/4 of Section 32 as shown. The new boundary between Parcels 1 and 2 of Partition No. 96-11 is established at the location approved by the land owners and to create a 160.00 acre tract to the west of the new line. The new boundary between Tracts 2 and 3, as shown on this survey, is established at the location approved by both land owners.
