



### BASIS OF BEARINGS

RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 1129 SEE NARRATIVE

#### **NARRATIVE**

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF TERRY ECCLES, PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR FOR THE CITY OF JOHN DAY. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO LOCATE AND MONUMENT A PROPOSED ADDITIONAL RIGHT OF WAY FOR A PORTION OF SKYLINE ROAD, AS SHOWN HEREON.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. WE MADE FIELD MEASUREMENTS TO LOCATE THE TOP OF THE CURRENT CUT BANK, SHOULDERS OF THE CURRENT ROAD AND THE APPURTENANT MONUMENTS FROM RECORD SURVEY NO. 1129 WHICH WAS SURVEYED BY ROBERT BAGETT IN 1989. DURING THE COURSE OF SURVEY NO. 1129, MR. BAGETT SET CENTERLINE AND RIGHT OF WAY MONUMENTS ON SW 4TH STREET AND SKYLINE ROAD.

I ACCEPT THE FOUND MONUMENTS, SHOWN HEREON FROM SURVEY NO. 1129. I HELD THE RECORD CENTER LINE DATA SHOWN ON SURVEY NO. 1129. I SET NEW MONUMENTS AT LOCATIONS APPROVED BY MR. ECCLES AND ACCORDING TO THE EVIDENCE FOUND. CENTERLINE MONUMENT NO. 102 WAS NOT RECOVERED DURING THIS SURVEY. IT IS UNDER SEVERAL FEET OF FILL.
