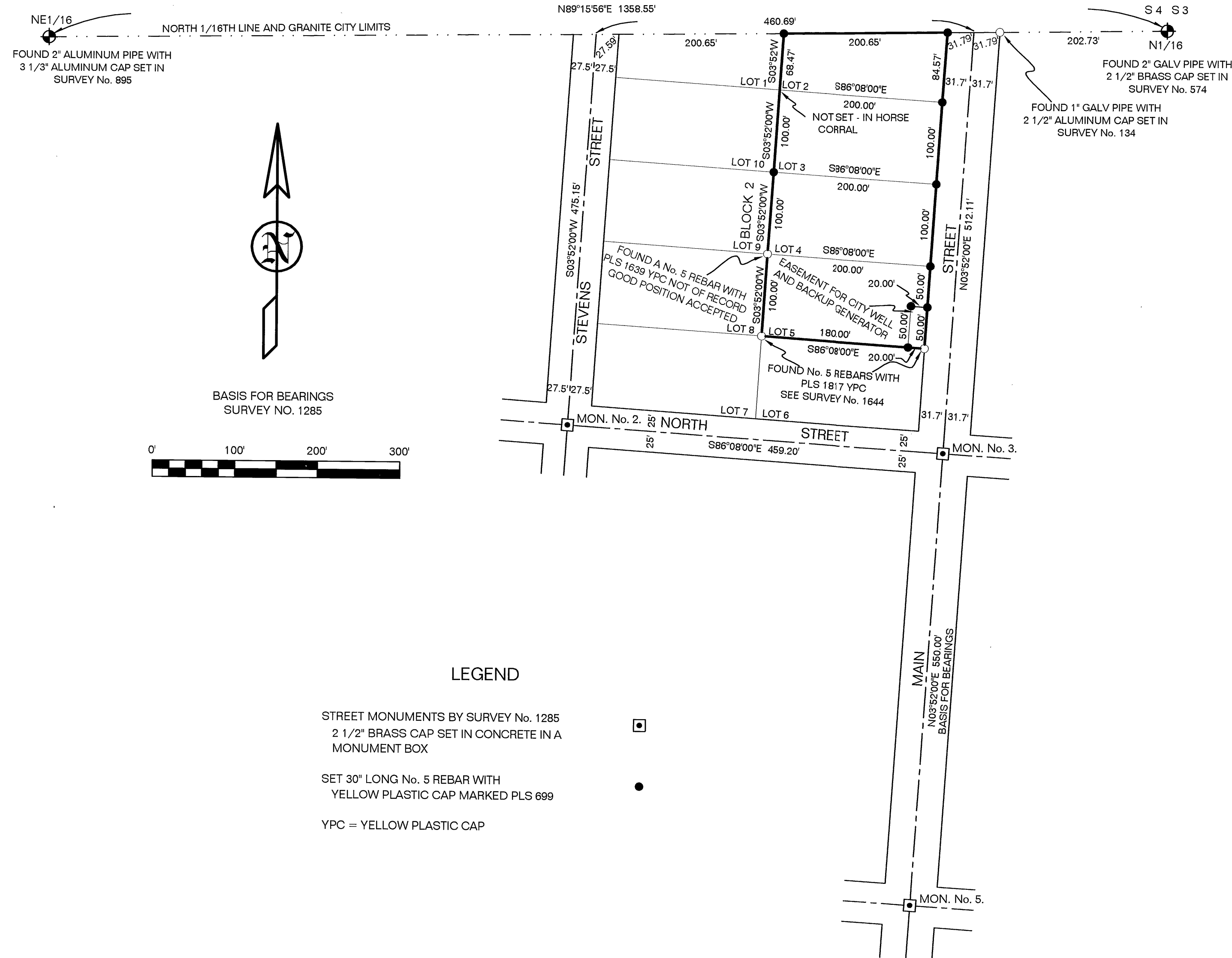


MAP OF SURVEY
Lots 2, 3, 4 & 5, Block 2, Original Town of Granite
SE1/4NE1/4 of Section 4, T9S, R35 1/2E, WM
Grant County, Oregon



NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO LOCATE AND MONUMENT THE CORNERS OF LOTS 2, 3, 4 AND 5, BLOCK 2, ORIGINAL TOWN OF GRANITE, IN SECTION 3, T9S, R35 1/2E, WM, GRANT COUNTY, OREGON, AT THE REQUEST OF BILL DUYN.

BOB BAGETT DID A COMPREHENSIVE SURVEY OF GRANITE IN 1993, WHICH WAS RECORDED AS GRANT COUNTY SURVEY No. 1285. HE RESOLVED A NUMBER OF CONFLICTING SURVEY PROBLEMS AND SET A NUMBER OF INTERSECTION MONUMENTS WHICH MAKE IT EASIER TO PERFORM A SURVEY IN GRANITE. HE HAS A VERY COMPREHENSIVE NARRATIVE ON HIS PLAT SO IT IS NOT REPEATED HERE.

I FOUND A No. 5 REBAR WITH A PLS 1639 YELLOW PLASTIC CAP AT THE NW CORNER OF LOT 5, BUT I DID NOT FIND A RECORD OF SURVEY NOR DID I FIND ANY OTHER MONUMENTS WITH THE SAME MARKINGS IN THE AREA. I ACCEPTED THE REBAR AT THE NW CORNER AS THE LOT CORNER AS IT WAS WITHIN THE ALLOWABLE SURVEY TOLERANCE OF 0.1 OF A FOOT AS PER OREGON STATE LAW.

I WAS REQUESTED TO MONUMENT THE CORNERS OF A 20'X50' PARCEL IN THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 5 TO DELINIATE A WELL EASEMENT FOR THE CITY OF GRANITE. THE PARCEL WILL ALSO HAVE A BACKUP GENERATOR INSTALLED FOR THE WELL PUMP DURING ELECTRICAL OUTAGES.

ALL BEARINGS AND DISTANCES SHOWN ON THIS PLAT ARE OF RECORD AND CONFIRMED BY MEASUREMENT.
