

NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF MARK HENSLEY, COUNTY ROAD MASTER, ACTING IN BEHALF OF THE GRANT COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO LOCATE THE EXISTING ROAD AND TO MONUMENT THE PROPOSED RIGHT OF WAY LINES, 30.00 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE CENTERLINE, AS SHOWN HEREON.

THE PRESENT ROAD IS ALMOST ENTIRELY ON COUNTY PROPERTY.

WE SET MONUMENTS AT THE NOMINAL 60 FOOT WIDTH, 30 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE EXISTING CENTERLINE.

AN ADDITIONAL WIDTH FOR ADEQUATE SLOPE PROTECTION OF A CUT AT THE WEST END FROM STATION 26+78.48 TO 27+94.01 LEFT IS IN ADDITION TO THE RIGHT OF WAY.

MY RESEARCH DISCLOSED THAT THE OLD RIGHT OF WAY FOR A PORTION OF THE ROAD IS DESCRIBED IN DEED BOOK 85, PAGES 558 AND 559 DATED SEPTEMBER 13 AND 14, 1961, RESPECTIVELY. ALSO, IN COMMISSIONER'S JOURNAL N-296, MEETING OF THE GRANT COUNTY COURT, HELD JUNE 28, 1973, I FOUND THE FOLLOWING ENTRY: "DECLARED A PRESCRIPTIVE RIGHT OF WAY ON ROAD #79 ON HARPER CREEK, NEAR MT. VERNON."

THE COUNTY INTENDS TO VACATE THE OLD RIGHT OF WAY. THE COUNTY WILL RETAIN A 60 FOOT WIDE RIGHT OF WAY ALONG THE RELOCATED ROAD THAT LIES WITHIN THE COUNTY PROPERTY. THE COUNTY WILL ACQUIRE NEW RIGHT OF WAY FROM LANDOWNER BELLINGER, BRADLEY AND HARPER WITHIN THE REMAINING PART OF THE NW1/4SW1/4 ALONG THE RELOCATED EXISTING ROAD, AS SHOWN HEREON.

I PREPARED A LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR NEW RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITION FROM BELLINGER, BRADLEY AND HARPER OVER AND ACROSS THEIR PORTION OF THE NW1/4SW1/4 OF SECTION 28.
