NARRATIVE


This survey was performed at the request of Philip Merricks. The purpose of this survey was to establish the proposed boundary adjustment lines as shown.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing fence line and to position the property corners shown hereon.

From the monument at the C1/4 corner of Section 1, I held the plat record distances shown on the plat of the Town of Monument and the plat of Mrs. S.J. Wilson's Addition to the Town of Monument to position Wilson Street. The easterly line is a proposed boundary agreement. The south and west lines are proposed boundary adjustments between tax lots 2500 and 2501 as shown on tax map 09S 27E 01CA.
