NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of George Ponte, on behalf of the Oregon Department of Forestry. The purpose of this survey was to locate and monument the boundary adjustment lines shown hereon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing monuments and the new corner positions agreed to by Mr. Ponte and Jack Cavender. I found and accepted an iron pipe at the NW corner of the Dept. of Forestry tract which is called for in Book 49, Page 191, deeds of Grant County. The SW corner of the Old Town of Monument Block 1, Lot 10, was established using the plat record distances from the C1/4 corner and the local improvements.
