




This survey was performed at the request of Claude White. The purpose of this survey was to locate the boundaries of the property described in Grant County Deed Instrument No. 20062314.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Measurements were made to locate the existing monuments shown, which I accept, and the fences and the John Day River. I found several 1" iron pins which are typical of the type of monument set by the Oregon Department of Transportation. There is no record of these monuments in the Grant County Surveyor records. I accepted the monuments shown to represent the north right of way line of Highway No. 26 and intersected the west line of the E1/2E1/2NE1/4SW1/4 to establish the SW corner of this property.

I subdivided the SE1/4 of the section in the usual manner to determine the east boundary and set an offset monument north of the river as shown.




