This survey was performed at the request of Tony Johns. The purpose of this survey was to locate the boundaries of the proposed boundary agreement as shown hereon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing monuments and the existing fence lines. The monument set on the south right of way line of County Road No. 62 was placed in the existing fence line and on a line projected N89°30'03"E from the found monument set in Survey No. 714.

The new monuments were set in the existing fence line and a description of the property to be conveyed to the Prairie Cemetery Maintenance District was prepared.
