


COUNTY SURVEYOR'S NARRATIVE

THIS MAP IS FILED FOR THE RECORD, DURING THE COURSE OF RESEARCHING RECORDS AT THE GRANT COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT, JASON HATFIELD, PLS, LOCATED THIS SET OF UNRECORDED MAPS, WHICH WAS PREPARED BY JIM HANLEY, PLS.

THE MAP INDICATES THAT MONUMENTS WERE SET ALONG THE RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF LAYCOCK CREEK AND ALONG THE COUNTY ROAD RIGHT OF WAY LINE IN SECTION 25, 11, 45, 1, 3, 30E.

THE MAPS HAVE BEEN SCANNED AND ARE IN THEIR ORIGINAL CONDITION OTHER THAN THIS NARRATIVE AND THE SHEET NUMBER AND MAP OF SURVEY NUMBER IN THE LOWER RIGHT CORNER.


THE ORIGINAL PAPER COPIES OF THIS MAP WERE RETURNED TO THE GRANT COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT.
