NARRATIVE

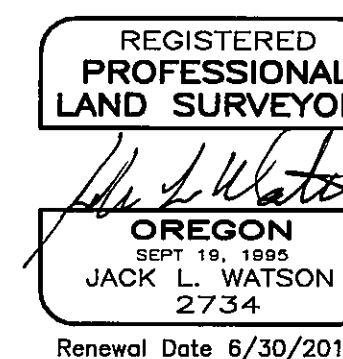
