

RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 896 AS SHOWN

NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF DAVID HAWLEY, ATTORNEY, ON BEHALF OF JULIA NEWTON. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO LOCATE AND REPLACE IF NECESSARY, THE PROPERTY CORNERS OF THE TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED IN DEED INSTRUMENT NO. 20101818, RECORDS OF GRANT COUNTY, OREGON. MR. HAWLEY ALSO REQUESTED THAT I MARK WITH MONUMENTS, THE 30 FOOT WIDE ACCESS EASEMENT LYING EAST OF AND ADJACENT TO THE SUBJECT PROPERTY.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. I MADE FIELD MEASUREMENTS TO LOCATE APPURTENANT MONUMENTS FROM SURVEY NO.'S 896, 932 AND 1418, AS SHOWN HEREON. THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SUBJECT TRACT WAS MISSING. I SET A NEW MONUMENT AT THE RECORD POSITION, WHICH I DETERMINED BY LOCATING THE MONUMENTS TO THE WEST AND SOUTH OF THE NORTHEAST PROPERTY CORNER.


