## NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF JAN O'RORKE. THE PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY WAS MONUMENT AND POST WITH LATH AND FLAGGING A PORTION OF THE NORTH LINE OF THE \$1/2 OF GOVERNMENT LOT 4, SECTION 19, T.10S., R.33E., W.M., AS SHOWN HEREON.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. I FOUND THE FOLLOWING SURVEY RECORDS:

THE ORIGINAL GENERAL LAND OFFICE SURVEY OF THE RANGE LINE BETWEEN T.10S., R.32E AND T.10S., R.33E., WAS CONDUCTED BY HERMAN GRADON, U.S., DEPUTY SURVEY IN 1881 UNDER CONTRACT NO. 383.

DOUGLAS FERGUSON, PLS SET THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 19 AND THE W1/16 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 AND 30. SEE RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO.'S 529 AND 624, RESPECTIVELY

THE W1/4 CORNER AND CW1/16 CORNERS WERE SET IN 1989 BY TYLER PARSONS. SEE RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 1094.

I ACCEPT THE FOUND MONUMENTS SHOWN HEREON AND SET NEW MONUMENTS ACCORDING TO THE EVIDENCE FOUND. DEED INSTRUMENT NO. 20140445 STATES THAT THE WORKMAN BOUNDARY LINE IS THE CENTER OF FOREST SERVICE ROAD 36. I SET AN OFFSET PIN ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE \$1/2 OF GOVERNMENT LOT 4 APPROXIMATELY 24.4 FEET FROM THE CENTERLINE OF SAID ROAD.
