

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Ralph Miller. The purpose of this survey was to monument the property corners, see Grant County Deed Instrument No. 101244.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing monuments and the new corner positions. Evidence of the original corner was found at the N1/4 corner of Section 1, which I re-monumented. I accept the Grant County Surveyor monuments at the NE corner and NW corner and at the E1/4 corner of Section 1. The SW section corner and the S1/4 corner were established in Survey No. 1411, which I accept. The section was subdivided in accordance with the 2009 Manual of Surveying Instructions and monuments were established as shown.

This survey was performed using a Leica TCR 1101 total station.
