## **NARRATIVE**

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF GERALD DEDMON. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MARK THE BOUNDARIES OF THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN DEED RECORD BOOK 138, PAGE 777, DEED RECORDS OF GRANT COUNTY, OREGON, WHICH IS DESCRIBED AS LOT 4,

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE DEED AND SURVEY RECORDS. I FOUND THE FOLLOWING APPURTENANT PLATS AND MAPS OF SURVEY: THE 1930 PLAT OF SENECA WAS PLATTED BY M.D. HALEY. IN 1974 MARC PALMER, PLS SET CENTERLINE MONUMENTS ALONG THIRD STREET. HIS MAP IS RECORDED AS RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 342. IN 1978 MR. PALMER SET MONUMENTS AT NEARLY ALL OF THE BLOCK CORNERS IN SENECA SUBDIVISION. THE MAP IS RECORDED AS RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 496. IN 2013 JASON HATFIELD, PLS, RECOVERED SEVERAL OF PALMER'S MONUMENTS AND SET NEW CORNERS FOR HIS SURVEY IN BLOCK 16 OF SENECA, SEE RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 1974.

DURING THIS SURVEY, I FOUND AND ACCEPTED THE FOLLOWING CORNERS FROM RECORD SURVEY NO. 496: THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF BLOCK 7, THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF BLOCK 8, THE NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST CORNERS OF BLOCK 9. I ALSO RECOVERED AND ACCEPTED THE NORTHEAST AND SOUTHEAST CORNERS OF BLOCK 16 FROM RECORD SURVEY NO. 1974.

THE FOUND MONUMENTS AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF BLOCK 9 AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF BLOCK 10 WERE FOUND TO BE OUT OF TOLERANCE AND ARE NOT ACCEPTED FOR THIS SURVEY. I ALSO FOUND UNRECORDED 1" IRON PIPES BELOW THE GROUND SURFACE NEAR THE NORTHEAST AND SOUTHWEST CORNERS OF BLOCK B. I DID NOT LOCATE THESE MONUMENTS BY SURVEY, BUT THEY WERE APPROXIMATELY 0.5 FT. SOUTH OF THE RESPECTIVE BLOCK

I SET THE NEW MONUMENTS SHOWN HEREON BASED ON THE EVIDENCE FOUND.

- 1. THE OUT BUILDING ON LOT 3 ENCROACHES 4.7 FT., MORE OR LESS ONTO LOT 4. (MEASUREMENT IS TO BUILDING EAVES)
- 2. FOUND PIN 0.49 FT. SOUTH AND 0.63 FT. EAST OF CALCULATED BLOCK CORNER POSITION. PIN NOT ACCEPTED
- 3. FOUND PIN 1.10 FT. SOUTH AND 0.40 FT. WEST OF CALCULATED BLOCK CORNER POSITION. PIN NOT ACCEPTED
