NARRATIVE


This survey was performed at the request of Tad Houpt. The purpose of this survey was to locate and monument the east line of the W1/2SE1/4 of Section 14, T14S, R31E, W.M. Deed reference Instrument No. 980560, deeds of Grant County, Oregon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing monuments and to establish the new monuments. I accept the positions of the found monuments shown hereon from record survey numbers 248, 613 and 1890. I found two unrecorded iron pipes, as noted on this plat, which I did not accept.

I also tied the BLM monument at the closing corner near the NE corner of Section 24. This corner monument was set from original evidence of the closing corner and does not fall on the section line as noted.

The new monuments along the east line of the W1/2SE1/4 were set in accordance with the evidence found and the 2009 Manual of Surveying Instructions.

This survey was performed using an RTK GPS instrument.
