


BASIS OF BEARINGS

NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF NICK GREEN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JOHN DAY AND IRON TRIANGLE LOGGING, INC. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO ADJUST THE COMMON PROPERTY LINE BETWEEN THE TWO SUBJECT PROPERTIES SO THAT IRON TRIANGLE WOULD RECEIVE 6.00 ACRES FROM THE CITY. THE IRON TRIANGLE TRACT IS DESCRIBED IN DEED RECORD BOOK 129, PAGE 816 AND IN DEED INSTRUMENT NO. 20112494, THE CITY'S TRACT IS DESCRIBED IN DEED INSTRUMENT NO 20171037, DEED RECORDS OF GRANT COUNTY, OREGON

THE COMMON LINE BETWEEN THESE TWO PROPERTIES WAS ORIGINALLY SURVEYED IN 1981 BY ROBERT D. BAGETT, PLS AS SHOWN ON RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 671. MR. BAGETT'S MAP AND BOTH DEEDS SHOW THAT THE RECORD BOUNDARY LINE IS ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF THE N1/2NW1/4SE1/4 SECTION 22.

I HELD THE RECORD BEARING OF N.00°23'30"W. BETWEEN THE FOUND MONUMENT AT THE S1/4 CORNER OF SAID SECTION 22 AND THE FOUND IRON PIN SET DURING RECORD SURVEY NO. 610 AS THE BASIS OF BEARINGS FOR THIS SURVEY. I FOUND THE IRON PIN AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE IRON TRIANGLE TRACT (PRIOR TO THIS ADJUSTMENT) DISTURBED. THE PIN WAS MOST LIKELY DISTURBED DURING FENCE BUILDING OPERATIONS. THIS PIN IS NOT ACCEPTED AS BEING IN ITS RECORD POSITION

I HELD THE BEARING OF S.00°06'21"E. BETWEEN THE FOUND MONUMENTS ALONG THE EAST LINE OF THE NW1/4SE1/4 AND THE SW1/4SE1/4 OF SAID SECTION 22. THESE TWO MONUMENTS WERE NOT PREVIOUSLY TIED TOGETHER BY SURVEY, BUT THEY ARE BOTH INTENDED TO BE ON THE SAME LINE. I FOUND THE 5/8"X30" IRON PIN FOR THE SE1/16 CORNER LYING ON THE GROUND NEAR THE RECORD POSITION SHOWN ON SURVEY NO. 671 THE RECORD POSITION FALLS IN THE CONCRETE AT THE BASE OF A CORNER POST OF A CHAIN-LINK FENCE

I ACCEPT ALL OTHER RECORD MONUMENTS SHOWN HEREON AND SET NEW PINS AT LOCATIONS APPROVED BY BOTH LANDOWNERS.


