


NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of John Conley. The purpose of this survey was to locate and monument the west line of the NE1/4NW1/4 and the south line lying west of Highway 395. Mr. Conley's property is described in Instrument No. 2017-2092, deeds of Grant County, Oregon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing monuments and to set the corners shown. I accept the monuments shown as found and divided the NW1/4 of Section 6 in accordance with the 2009 BLM Manual of Surveying Instructions. The State Highway Drawing No. 9B-7-24 shows the monuments set on the west right of way line. I intersected the west right of way line and the south line of the NE1/4NW1/4 and set a monument as directed by Mr. Conley.

This survey was performed using RTK GPS receivers.


