


RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 963

## BASIS OF BEARINGS

## **NARRATIVE**

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF LUKE PALAN, OWNER OF THE LAND DESCRIBED IN DEED INSTRUMENT NO. 20181530, DEED RECORDS OF GRANT COUNTY, OREGON. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MONUMENT AND MARK WITH STEEL POSTS AND FLAGGING, THE SOUTH LINE OF MR. PALAN'S PROPERTY. THIS REQUIRED A DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF A PORTION OF SECTION 12, T.13S., R.34E., WM.

THE HISTORY OF SURVEYS FOR SECTION 12 IS AS FOLLOWS: THE SURVEY OF THE EAST LINE OF T.13S., R.34E. AND THE SUBDIVISION OF THE SAME TOWNSHIP WAS ORIGINALLY CONDUCTED BY U.S. DEPUTY SURVEYOR JOHN B. DAVID UNDER CONTRACT NO. 131, DATED JUNE 8, 1869. THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 12 WAS SUBSEQUENTLY REVISITED BY U.S. DEPUTY SURVEYOR BAMFORD ROBB UNDER CONTRACT NO. 383 DATED MARCH 26, 1881. DURING HIS SURVEY MR. ROBB STATES THAT HE REPAIRED THE ORIGINAL MONUMENTS PREVIOUSLY SET BY JOHN B. DAVID.

IN AUGUST 1986 A DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 12 WAS CONDUCTED FOR THE MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST BY GEORGE W. COLVIN, JR., PLS. DURING HIS SURVEY, MR. COLVIN EITHER RECOVERED OR ESTABLISHED ALL OF THE SECTION AND 1/4 SECTION CORNERS OF SECTION 12. HE PERPETUATED THE CORNER POSITIONS WITH ALUMINUM MONUMENTS AT EACH CORNER.

WE RECOVERED AND ACCEPT THE CONTROLLING CORNERS, SHOWN HEREON, SET BY MR. COLVIN. I ESTABLISHED THE 1/16 CORNERS BETWEEN THE N1/2S1/2 AND THE S1/2S1/2 OF SECTION 12 WITH REFERENCE TO THE 2009 BLM MANUAL OF SURVEYING INSTRUCTIONS. AT THE REQUEST OF MR. PALAN, WE POSTED THE SOUTH LINE OF HIS PROPERTY WITH STEEL POSTS AND FLAGGING. SEE CORNER RESTORATION REPORTS FILED SEPARATELY WITH THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE FOR ADDITIONAL DETAILS ON THE 1/16 CORNERS AND THE ACCESSORIES SET DURING THIS SURVEY.
