NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Judy Cavender, on behalf of the Jack Eldon Cavender Revocable Living Trust. The purpose of this survey was to locate the proposed property line adjustment as shown hereon. The two properties are described in Instrument No.'s 032080 and 20182383, deeds of Grant County, Oregon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing monument at the SE corner of Section 25 and to establish a monument on the proposed new boundary. Section 25 was not subdivided during this survey. The monument set on the new proposed property line is offset from the west line of the SE1/4NW1/4 of Section 25.

This survey was performed using RTK GPS receivers.
