This survey was performed at the request of John Conley. The purpose of this survey was to locate and monument the adjusted property line as described in Instrument No. 20201984, deeds of Grant County, Oregon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing monuments and to set the corners shown. I accept the monuments shown as found and established the new property corner monuments as directed by Mr. Conley. I prepared a new description of the additional piece of land and the deed has been recorded. I flagged the new line for the purpose of building a fence line.
