SEARCH IN THE FIELD RECOVERED THE MONUMENTS SET BY THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT SHOWN ON THE PLAT AND I HELD THEM AS FOUND. AT THE SOUTH ONE—QUARTER CORNER LOCATION I FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL GLO CORNER. BUT THERE IS AN OLD ROCK JACK FENCE CORNER. I BELIEVE THIS SAME ROCK JACK FENCE CORNER THAT WAS HELD AS THE CORNER LOCATION DURING SURVEY B24 BY VERNON L. GLAZE. I HELD SAID FENCE CORNER AS THE LOCATION FOR THE SOUTH ONE—QUARTER CORNER.
