SAID DEED. THIS REQUIRED A DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 27, T.11S.,

WE BEGAN THIS SURVEY BY LOCATING THE RECORD CONTROLLING MONUMENTS SHOWN HEREON AT THE FOLLOWING CORNERS: THE NORTHEAST SECTION CORNER AND E1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27 AND AT THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHWEST SECTION CORNERS OF SECTION 28. WE PROCEEDED TO SEARCH FOR EVIDENCE OF GENERAL LAND OFFICE (GLO) CORNERS AT THE N1/4 CORNER AND S1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28 AND AT THE NORTHWEST, SOUTHWEST, SOUTHEAST, N1/4, W1/4 AND S1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 27. ADDITIONALLY, WE EXPANDED THE SEARCH AREA TO THE W1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34. WE FOUND AND ACCEPTED ORIGINAL GLO EVIDENCE AT THE W1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34. AND AT THE SI/4 CORNER OF SECTION 37. THESE CORNERS WERE REMOVED. SECTION 34 AND AT THE S1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27. THESE CORNERS WERE REMONUMENTED WITH GRANT COUNTY SURVEYOR BRASS CAPS. I ACCEPTED A FOUND UNMARKED STONE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 27. THE STONE WAS GLO CALL SIZE, IN A MOUND OF STONES AND FIT HARMONIOUSLY WITH OTHER CORNERS IN THE VICINITY. AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27, WE MADE A DILIGENT SEARCH, BUT FOUND NO GLO EVIDENCE. I ACCEPTED A FENCE CORNER AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL GLO POSITION. AFTER A DILIGENT SEARCH, I HAVE DETERMINED THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 27 LOST. WE SET A NEW MONUMENT BASED ON DOUBLE PROPORTIONATE MEASURE BETWEEN THE NEAREST FOUND OR ESTABLISHED CORNERS, AS SHOWN. SEE CORNER RESTORATION RECORDS FILED SEPARATELY IN THE OFFICE OF THE GRANT COUNTY SURVEYOR FOR ADDITIONAL DETAILS ON THE CORNERS SET DURING THIS SURVEY AND THEIR ACCESSORIES.

WE PROCEEDED TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 27 WITH REFERENCE TO THE 2009 BLM MANUAL OF SURVEYING INSTRUCTIONS. WE SET IRON PINS AT THE CORNERS OF MR. WHITTEN'S PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DEED DESCRIPTION AND PER HIS REQUEST, WE POSTED THE SOUTH AND WEST PROPERTY LINES WITH STEEL "U" POSTS AND FLAGGING. GOD BLESS AMERICA.


