NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Wayne Dickens to locate and mark the Northerly boundary of the real property described in Deed Instrument #20201047 of the Grant County Deed Records.

Record survey monuments are found as shown.

The above reference deeds calls an iron rod at the Northwest corner. Near the called position of said Northwest corner, I find a 5/8" rebar pin, not driven very deeply into the ground. I find no survey record showing the setting of this iron rod. There has been activity in the area, such as road work and the installation of a utility pole. Based on the very specific calls in the deed, being to the 100th of a foot and to the second in bearings, I choose not to accept the iron rod. I set the new pins based on the deed calls, online and at proportionate distance between found monuments from Grant County Map of Survey #643.

I then stake and ribbon the North line for fencing.
