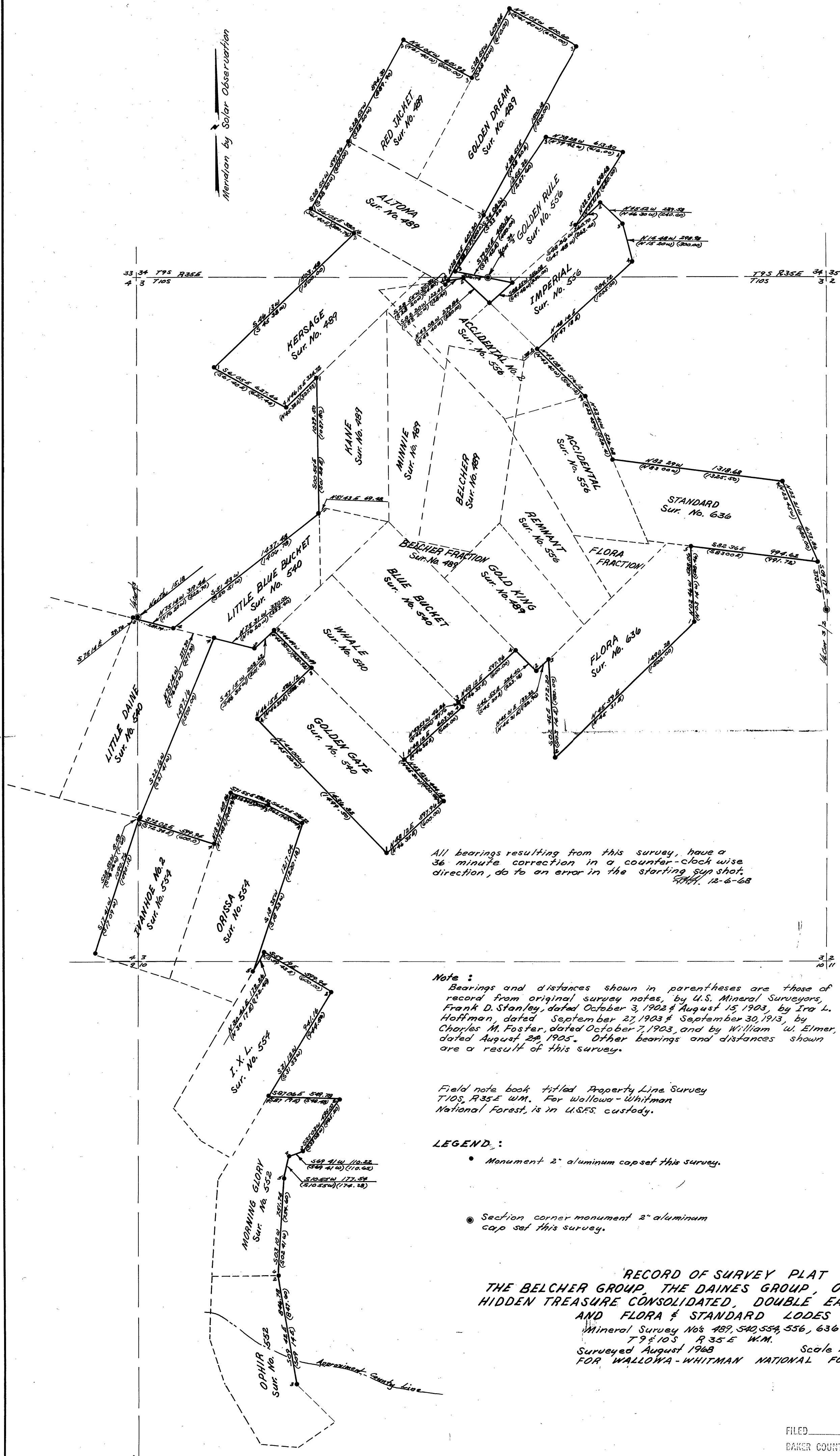




All bearings resulting from this survey, have a 36 minute correction in a counter-clock wise direction, do to an error in the starting sun shot.
