A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set in accordance with the evidence found as shown hereon.

At S1/4 Cor. Sec. 33

Found 1 1/2" galvanized iron pipe with brass cap, set by Grant Co. Surveyor.

Fd. pin 0.10' North and 0.25' East.

Pin probably disturbed when fence was built.

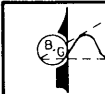
BASIS OF BEARINGS
