**NARRATIVE;**

This survey was performed at the request Blair Carpenter of Edward Hines Lumber Company to delineate the tract of land as shown on this map.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey, field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set in accordance with the evidence found as shown hereon.

This survey also corrects Survey No. 179, performed by my partner Duane Griffith in April 1970. In Survey No. 179 an error was made in tying the North 1/4 corner of Section 22, thus the monuments which were established were not placed on the true North-South centerline of said section. The monuments which I found in place are called on this map and the differences shown. New monuments were set in the proper position.
