THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED UNDER MY DIRECT SUPERVISION AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF OREGON. THIS SURVEY WAS TO MARK THE EXTERIOR LINES OF SEC. 21. THE ORIGINAL SURVEY OF THE TOWNSHIP WAS MADE BY S.W. LACKLAND IN 1880 AND THEN DISCONTINUED ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTIONS 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, AND 18. IN 1901 HOMER D. ANGELL COMPLETED THE SURVEY OF THE TOWNSHIP SETTING CLOSING CORNERS ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED SECTIONS. I RETRACED THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 16 AND THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 15 TO THE 1/4 CORNER. I PLACED THE N.W. CORNER AND THE N.E. CORNER ON THE RETRACED LINE AT THE TRUE POINT OF INTERSECTION. ALL CORNERS FOUND WERE REMONUMENTED, (SEE COUNTY CORNER RECORDS). THIS SURVEY WAS MADE BY AND FOR CROWN ZELLERBACH CORP.

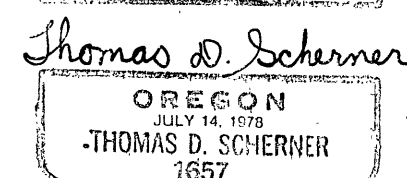
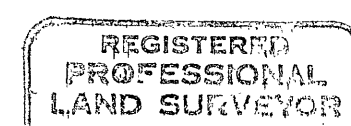
