

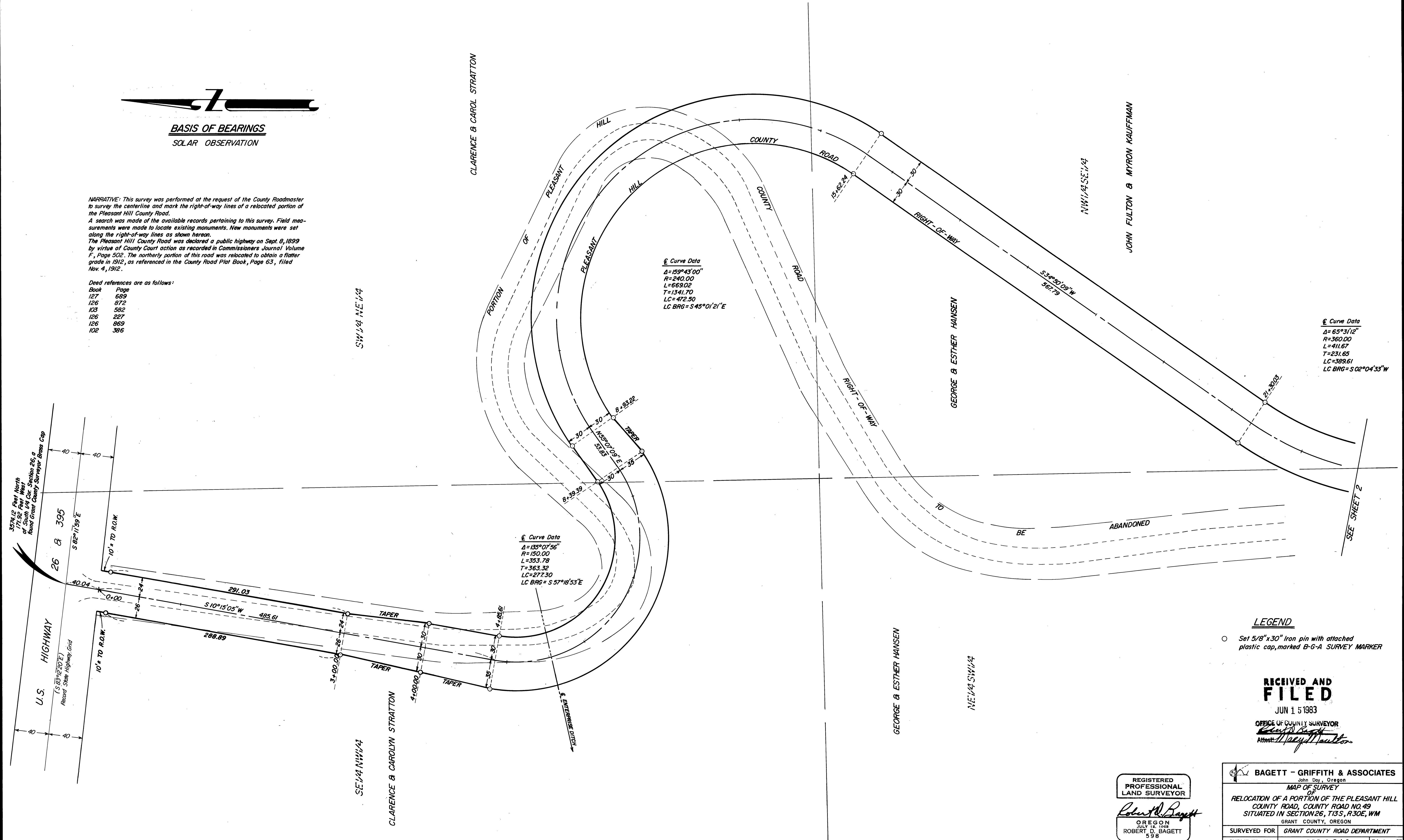


BASIS OF BEARINGS
SOLAR OBSERVATION

NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of the County Roadmaster to survey the centerline and mark the right-of-way lines of a relocated portion of the Pleasant Hill County Road.
A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set along the right-of-way lines as shown hereon.
The Pleasant Hill County Road was declared a public highway on Sept. 8, 1899 by virtue of County Court action as recorded in Commissioners Journal Volume F, Page 502. The northerly portion of this road was relocated to obtain a flatter grade in 1912, as referenced in the County Road Plat Book, Page 63, filed Nov. 4, 1912.
