NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Clyde Holliday. Originally the survey was to determine the deed lines between the Holliday Ranch and the Southworth Ranch in Sections 8,16, and 17. These deed lines followed the section and sectional subdivisional lines. During the course of the survey I discovered that very little original corner evidence existed and had to go beyond the sections involved to obtain adequate control for the lines of the sections involved. It was during this time that Holliday and Southworth reached an agreement on a land exchange. The fence lines shown hereon will now form the line between the two parties once the deeds are exchanged. I monnumented said fence line at the major angle points, the fence generally lies along the courses shown hereon. Also as a part of the land exchange Southworth agreed to deed to Holliday his lands in sections 5 & 8 lying west of the John Day - Burns Highway and north of the fence line that I have shown hereon running Southwest and West through the NE I/4 of said section 8.
