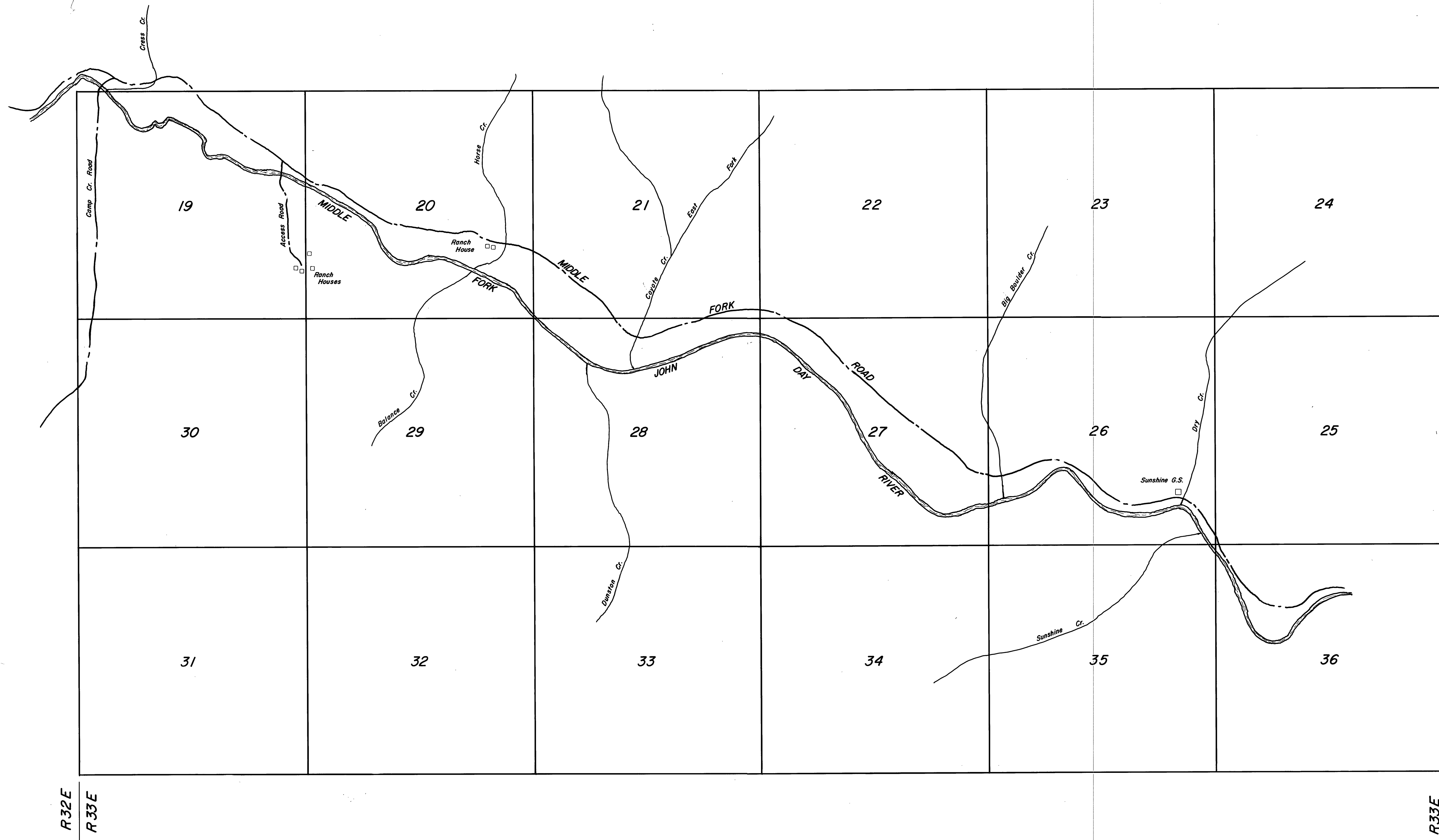


A PORTION OF THE
