The North line of Section 29 being S 89° 57' 14" W as per Grant County map of survey number 571

- Found 2 1/2" aluminum pipe with National Park Service aluminum cap attached, set in 6" diameter concrete collar
- ⊙ Set 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with National Park Service aluminum cap attached, set in 6" diameter concrete collar
- ⊙ Set 3 1/2" diameter National Park Service brass cap grouted into drill hole in rock outcrop
