



BASIS OF BEARING

The forward bearing as published by the U.S.C. & G.S. from \triangle Mills to \triangle Mills Az.

NARRATIVE

This survey was made for the National Park Service to establish the 10 acre parcel as shown. I found the South quarter corner of Section 29, a 1" pipe with brass cap in a mound of stone, marked 1/4 in each quadrant. The location of the parcel was pointed out by National Park Service personnel. The access road as deeded is described from the North 1/4 corner of Section 29, which I did not find. It appears this description would put the road in the very near proximity of where the existing road is now located. I found no unusual conditions.
