NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Lorene Allen, Grant County Judge. The purpose of this survey was to locate and describe the lower portion of the Dick Creek Road in its historic location. I began by asking Rob Ray Munro, a local rancher who had been raised on, and had once owned the land that this road is located on, to point out to me the old location of the road. Mr. Munro came with us and showed us the original location of the road. Once Mr. Munro pointed out the original road location to us, we could identify the old cuts, fills, ruts, and general route of the road. Some of the old juniper logs still exist at the original lower crossing of Dick Creek. We located, by survey, the center of this road and set monuments along the way, 15 feet on each side of the centerline of the road as described and shown hereon. 40d nails were set at the Q angle points. I found no prior record of this road having been located by survey.
