

NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Charles Rumsey to delineate the tracts of land shown hereon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monments were set in accordance with the evidence found and by utilizing the deed records, record plats, and maps of survey.

A 2.5 foot gap may exist in the deed description of Deeds Book 132

A 2.5 foot gap may exist in the deed description of Deeds Book 132 Page 617-619, tract 1-(b) & tract 1-(c). A quit claim deed and/or suit to quiet title was suggested to Mr. Rumsey to clear this up. The intent of the deeds was to have a common line between tracts 1-(b) & 1-(c) as shown hereon. The east line of tract 1-(b) is along the east line of the NWI/4 NWI/4 of section 11. This line was established through development of the Prairie City Land Co. 1st Addition plat to avoid conflict with that plat, which affects the tract 1-(b) shown hereon. Also according to the deed descriptions there appears to be a gap along the centerline of Johnson Ave., which is vacated.

The southerly line of tract 1-(b) is called to the north bank of the river in

the southerly line of tract I-(b) is called to the north bank of the river in the deed descriptions. We have located the north bank of the river as shown hereon. The river has moved generally north in this area. According to local residents the river moved naturally, slowly and imperceptably in this area. This indicates that the boundary line of tract I-(b) still remains the north bank of the river.

The one inch iron pipe found at the SE corner of Riverside Addition was recovered during this survey. Riverside Addition was positioned from this pipe. This pipe was found to be 1.3 feet West of the 1/16 line as shown hereon.
