



**NARRATIVE:** This survey was performed at the request of Bernard Bentz. The purpose of the survey was to create a dividing line across the Bentz Ranch. A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set at locations approved by Mr. Bentz. The northern line of this survey generally follows along an existing fence line. Due to extensive section corner obliteration in this area, I tied this survey to the southwest corner of section 9 which was monumented in 1981 by Carl Sundet, O.P.L.S. 1664. This section corner is remonumented with a 2-V2 alum. cap. See remonumentation records. I found no unusual conditions with this survey.
