

NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Bud Hankins, City Maintenance Superintendent, acting in behalf of the Town of Canyon City. The purpose of this survey was to locate the northeily line of a portion of those certain wooden stairs and wooden walkway in what is commonly referred to as East Bridge St.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set along the Nly edge of the wooden walkway approx. four feet Nly of the NE cor. of the Michael Knadler property and at the northwesterly corner of the wooden stairs.

The city intends to quitclaim the area between the north line of the wooden walkway & stairs and the north line of the Knadler property to the Knadler's.

A search of the available records revealed no deed or dedication of East Bridge St. to the Town of Canyon City. Bud Hankins informed me that the city may have unrecorded documents concerning this in their files. I have never found a plat of Kellys Addition although Kellys Addition is commonly referred to in the deed records. Perhaps the plat is in the citys' files. I encouraged Mr. Hankins to research the city records.
