NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Lane Burton. The purpose of this survey was to locate the westerly line of the George Burton lot. A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. A new monument was set in accordance with the evidence found. The 2 inch iron pin was found at the southwest corner of the Burton lot, as shown on the unrecorded map by Vic Coffey, P.E. (attached to Map of Survey No.s 249 and 883). I found no unusual conditions during this survey.
