## Surveyor's Certificate

I, Jack L. Watson, Professional Land Surveyor, registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, Parcels 1, 2 and 3 of this land partition. This partition is situated in the SE1/4SE1/4 of Section 1, T13S, R26E, W.M., City of Dayville, Grant County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" iron pin at the SW corner of Parcel 3, which I designate to be the Initial Point of this land partition, which is 432.81 feet north and 604.54 feet west of the SE corner of said Section 1; thence N35°27'20"E, 535.64 feet to the southerly right of way line of the County Road; thence S53°52'26"E, along the County Road, 78.00 feet; thence S35°28'02"W, 482.27 feet; thence N88°30'00"W, 93.91 feet to the point of beginning.

### Declaration

Know all people by these presents that we, Frank Schrier and Pat Schrier, husband and wife, do hereby declare we are the owners of the lands described in the Surveyor's Certificate, and that we have caused the same to be partitioned into parcels in accordance with the provisions of ORS Chapter 92 as shown hereon. We hereby grant to the future owners of Parcels 2 and 3 a 12 foot wide private access easement, over and across Parcels 1 and 2, for ingress and egress, as shown.

SAID PARCELS ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) Rights of the public in streets, roads and highways.
- 2) Any and all matters, including easements and assessments, if any, pertaining to irrigation

Right of way easement for utility and incidental purposes. No width is given, the easement is not shown due to insufficient data given in the deed.
- 9) An easement, including the terms and provisions thereof, to California-Pacific Utilities Company, a corp., dated June 24, 1970, recorded August 14, 1970, in Deed Book 104, Page 111, records of Grant County, Oregon. Right of way easement for utility and incidental purposes, 15 feet in width. The easement is not shown due to insufficient data given in the deed.
