DECLARATION

Know all people by these presents that, Del R. Woodcock and Jana L. Woodcock, husband and wife, do hereby declare we are the owner of the lands described in the Surveyor's Certificate, and that we have caused the same to be partitioned into parcels in accordance with the provisions of ORS Chapter 92.

We reserve that portion of the 50 foot wide private access easement which crosses Parcel 1 shown on this plat, for ingress and egress, to Parcel 3 of Land Partition No. 2005-24.

We grant that portion of the 50 foot wide private access easement, over and across Parcels 1 and 2, for ingress and egress to Parcel 2 of this land partition, and for ingress and egress to Parcels 1 and 2 of Land Partition No. 2006-9, and for ingress and egress to Parcel 3 of Land Partition No. 2005-24 and all future divisions thereof.

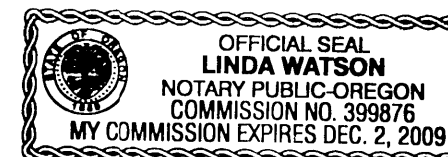
We reserve a 25 foot wide private utility easement, over and across Parcels 1 and 2, for electric power, telephone, water and sewer utilities.

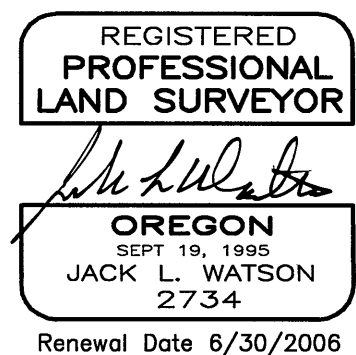
