NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF BOB ARMSTRONG ON BEHALF OF LOOP RANCH, LLC AND MARILYN KIGHT. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO MONUMENT THE

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. FIELD MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE TO LOCATE EXISTING MONUMENTS SHOWN ON RECORD SURVEY NO.'S 374, 1387 AND 1624. SURVEY NO. 374, TITLED "LAYCOCK MEADOWS LAND PARTITION" WAS PERFORMED BY ROBERT BAGETT, PLS IN 1975. THE MAP CONTAINS A NOTE STATING "SECTION AND 1/4 SECTION LINES SHOWN ARE APPROXIMATE. MANY OF THE SECTION AND 1/4 SECTION CORNERS ARE LOST. THE ABUTTING LAND OWNERS HAVE BOUNDARY AGREED WITH THE OWNER TO EXISTING FENCELINES AND LINES OF MUTUAL BENEFIT AS SHOWN ON THIS PLAT." I SEARCHED THE AVAILABLE DEED RECORDS, BUT FOUND NO INDICATION THAT THE AGREEMENTS WERE EVER PERFECTED. THEREFOR, I MAPPED THOSE PORTIONS OF THE BOUNDARY AS PER THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION IN DEED

A PORTION OF THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THIS PARTITION IS THE RESULT OF A PROPERTY LINE ADJUSTMENT, AS SHOWN ON SURVEY NO. 1624 PERFORMED BY CARL'STOUT. THE PROPERTY LINE ADJUSTMENT WAS PERFECTED BY INSTRUMENT NO.'S 220809 AND 220810. DURING THE COURSE OF THIS SURVEY, IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THE RECORD TIE TO THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 26 DESCRIBED IN SAID DEEDS IS IN ERROR BY APPROXIMATELY 61 FEET. UNFORTUNATELY, RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 1624 LACKS A COORDINATE CALL OR TIE TO THE SECTION CORNER AND LACKS SUFFICIENT DATA TO EVEN CALCULATE THE POSITION OF THE CORNER. THEREFOR, I TIED SEVERAL PINS ON THE GROUND FROM SAID SURVEY IN ORDER TO MAP THE BOUNDARY MORE ACCURATELY ON

I ACCEPT THE FOUND CONTROLLING MONUMENTS FROM THE AFOREMENTIONED SURVEYS.
NEW MONUMENTS WERE SET IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE EVIDENCE FOUND AND AT LOCATIONS APPROVED BY MR. ARMSTRONG, AS SHOWN HEREON.
