

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Jack L. Watson, Professional Land Surveyor, registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, Parcels 2 and 3 of this land partition and that Parcel 1 was not surveyed during this partition process. This partition is situated in the NW1/4NW1/4NE1/4, and the N1/2NE1/4SW1/4, and the NE1/4NW1/4SW1/4, and the E1/2W1/2NW1/4 of Section 36, T13S, R31E, W.M., Grant County, Oregon, described as follows:

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Dan Ellison. The purpose of this survey was to partition Mr. Ellison's property into 3 parcels.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found that the four quarter corners have been remonumented and the W1/16, and the N-S1/64 corner of Section 36 have been monumented by the BLM in 1989, filed as Survey No. 286 in the office of the Grant County Surveyor. The SW corner of Section 36 was remonumented by the Grant County Surveyor in 1971.

I found and tied the four quarter corners, the W1/16, the N-S1/64, and the SW corner of Section 36. I searched for the S1/16 and the CS1/16 corners shown on Record Map of Survey No. 306, but could find no evidence of them. The W1/16 corner on the south boundary of Section 36 is a BLM brass cap which was intended to replace a 5/8" iron pin set by Bob Bagett in Survey No. 228. I found the BLM monument to be in the same position as shown on Record Map of Survey No. 987. The BLM manages lands adjacent to Mr. Ellison's property, which are controlled by said W1/16 corner, therefore after consulting with the BLM and much deliberation in this office, it was decided to hold the monument where I found it, as shown hereon.

The SW1/4 of Section 36 was subdivided and the corners pertaining to Mr. Ellison's property were set as shown hereon. The division lines between the three parcels are at locations approved by Mr. Ellison.

This survey was performed with a Topcon GTS-4 total station, with a closed loop random traverse. I used a IBM compatible AST Brovo 486 computer and CG Survey software to perform the calculations.
