Know all people by these present that I, Reba V. Moorehouse, do hereby declare I am the owner of the lands described in the Surveyor's Certificate, and that I have caused the same to be partitioned into parcels in accordance with the provisions of ORS Chapter 92, as shown hereon.

SAID PARCELS ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING:

I, Jack Watson, Professional Land Surveyor, registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, Parcels 1, 2 and 3 of this land partition. This is a partition of Parcel 1, Land Partition Plat No. 98-03 and is situated in the NE1/4 of Section 28, T135, R31E, W.M., Grant County, Oregon, described as follows:
