

- Found 1½" iron pipe with attached 2½" brass cap, see Survey No. 7G.
- Found 3" iron pipe with attached 3" BLM brass cap, see Survey No. 130.
- Found 5/8" iron pin with attached yellow plastic cap marked "PLS 848", (unrecorded).
- Set 5/8"x30" iron pin with attached red plastic cap marked CORNERSTONE SURVEYING, INC.
- Set 5/8"x30" iron pin with attached 2" alum. cap see corner restoration records for details.
